

» Rules and Regulations Stand: 15 July 2007

Rules and Regulations for the “Enduro”, “Supermoto”, “Motocross” and “Superchamp” competitions during the 7th International KTM Festival
KTM reserves the right to change or alter these rules and regulations up to when the Festival begins.

General Regulations

Only those riders who have registered as such for the 7th International KTM Festival and have paid the necessary registration fee may take part in the competitions.

A transponder will be used to record the times of all riders taking part in the Supermoto and Motocross competitions. Should a crash occur, the rider is responsible for checking that the transponder is properly secured to the bike so that it will be able to operate correctly.

There is no division of classes within the competition. Starting positions in the final may not be passed on to another rider.

The start number must be clearly readable on the right and left hand of the motorcycle and on the front.

Flag Signals

- Black and White chequered flag being waved: finish line, race ended
- Yellow flag: Danger on the circuit/approach with caution
- Yellow flag being waved: Overtaking forbidden, obstacle on the course, ride slowly
- Red: Race disrupted
- Blue: Allow vehicle to overtake

Motocross competition

Nine preliminary heats each of 30 riders will be held for the Motocross competition. Riders will be grouped for the preliminary heats according to the order in which they have registered onsite. Registration is possible up to 11:00 a.m. Friday, September 7.

Duration of the heats: 10 minutes + 2 laps.

Starting line-up for the final race

1st from race one, 1st from race two, 1st from race three..... 2nd from race one, 2nd from race two 3rd from race one, 3rd from race 2etc.

Riders must be at the start with their motorcycles 10 minutes before the race, otherwise they will lose their starting position.

Riders are required to wear appropriate protective clothing and suitable helmets, all in good condition.

Onsite Race Director for all motocross races: Max Schaufler.

Supermoto competition

There will be nine heats each of 25 riders. Riders will be grouped for the preliminary heats according to the order in which they have registered onsite. Registration is possible up to 11:00 a.m. Saturday, September 8. It is only possible to take place with bikes fitted with Supermoto tyres.

Duration of the heats: 10 minutes + 2 laps.

Starting line-up for the final race

Starting line-up according to the time registered by the qualified riders in the heats.

Riders must be at the start with their motorcycles 10 minutes before the race, otherwise they will lose their starting position.

Riders are required to wear appropriate protective clothing and suitable helmets, all in good condition.

Riders who break and start early will be penalized by 20 seconds.

Onsite Race Director for all Supermoto races: Franz Weiss.

A special race for children with motorcycles up to 85 cc will be held if there are enough early registrations (minimum of 15 entries).

Enduro

A timed lap will be held for the Enduro competition during the period between 9:00 a.m. and 13:00 p.m. on Saturday.

The starting order will be according to the point in time that competitors report to the start. Riders will start at staged intervals.

The following motorcycles may start in the Enduro competition:

EXC Models, SX Models, 950 Super Enduro R und LC4 Enduro Models

Riders are required to wear appropriate protective clothing and suitable helmets, all in good condition.

Superchamp of the 7th International KTM Festivals

The best three will be chosen from the finals of the Supermoto, Motocross and Enduro competition according to the following modus.

Time MX Final + Time Supermoto Final + Time Enduro Test

The prize giving for the Superchamp will take place on Saturday evening in the big party tent.
